Pastor Search Committee Update: The pastor search committee was appointed by the Leadership Circle in September 2021 and received specific instructions from the Leadership Circle regarding the search for a Lead Pastor for FMC and the qualities to look for in candidates for this role. Based on guidance from the Leadership Circle and our CDC Conference Minister Doug Luginbill, the committee prepared a cover letter to be shared with potential candidates, as well as advertising copy which has been distributed to relevant publications and institutions. In November the committee received the first batch of completed application profiles, and a few additional profiles have been received since then. The committee reviews all profiles immediately upon receipt to discern the qualifications of the candidates and to invite suitable candidates to interview. The application process is slow, and applicant numbers are small. The pandemic has taken a particular toll on those in caregiving professions, and pastors and others in ministry roles have been impacted along with so many others. The committee is continuing to receive applications and act on these profiles. At this time the committee is also happy to continue to receive candidate recommendations from the congregation and other trusted advisors. The committee is confident that a candidate will emerge from this process soon, and is grateful for your prayers and your patience as we continue to work on this important task together.
