Today we welcome our Mission Partners, Bruce Yoder and Nancy Frey, and their children, Jeremiah and Deborah, as our guests on this Mission Sunday. The Frey Yoders are partnering with Mennonite and African Initiated church partners across West Africa. Their ministry is primarily in biblical and theological training among church leaders.

Our chancel arrangement is made of items from Burkina Faso. These items may be purchased at Ten Thousand Villages in Bluffton. Artisans and Ten Thousand Villages agree on a fair price that covers the cost of labor and materials and enables artisans to earn fair compensation for their work.

Congregational meeting: Today, immediately following the worship service, a congregational meeting will be held to vote on extending a call to Wanda Stopher to serve as our pastor.

Sunday school events for July:
